a public meeting being held by the New School  
to discuss plans for their proposed new building  
at 14<sup>th</sup> Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue



*Preliminary rendering of the proposed New School building –  
Cardozo building behind it at 12<sup>th</sup> Street is approx. 262 ft. tall.*

*The New School is proposing to replace its Albert List building at 65 Fifth Avenue with a new building that would rise 300 feet straight up over the entire site, and then set back with another 50 feet of mechanical penthouses on top.*

*However, the New School needs a variance to avoid having to set back the building below 300 feet, and to move mass from the western edge of the site to cover the entire lot. An as-of-right building (which does not need any approvals) could be taller than the proposed building, but would be thinner and place more of the mass on the western edge of the site.*

*The Greenwich Village Society for Historic Preservation has expressed serious concerns about the all-glass design of the proposed building and its extreme bulk.*
